

**Prichard-Murray Volunteer Fire Department
January 16, 2007 minutes**

A special meeting was held to discuss the EMS vehicle and the building addition.

EMS vehicle—We are swapping the pickup we have for a truck that can have boxes attached to the back. This model can not have boxes taking the place of the back of the pickup. This will be a straight trade with Dave Smith Motors. A vote approved this plan.

Building addition—The money available and the urgency of getting something built causes a change in plans to a pole building—40x48 feet—to be attached to the current fire hall. Research shows a kit to be put up by us would be in the neighborhood of \$12,000. This plan will maximize volunteer help and minimize the expense. We will get the building as far as we can get it this year with available funding and help. Ben Vaughn volunteered to lead this process, along with help from others. This building size will allow heated storage for the EMS vehicles and growth for the department. It is planned to start building about May 1. We will use the current heating system. Concrete floor will probably come later.

James will research the possible need to redo the bathroom for handicap accessibility as a part of this process.

We agreed that we will leave \$5,000 in the savings account for emergencies instead of spending it all on the building.
