EMS Vehicle

James is working with Dave Smith motors to get a vehicle that can carry the EMS boxes and have automatic transmission. By April, the state needs to be told when the project will be completed. Cobalt has a bid for a utility box for \$20,895, which includes a 3000 watt generator. We will probably pass on the generator, but may get a grill protector.

Addition

The county moratorium on building permits for sub-divisions, etc., will not affect getting a building permit for the addition. James is getting specifics of what we will need to do for the Americans with Disabilities Act from the inspector. Those changes will not need to be done immediately, but more as the interior is finished off.

Fundraising

The auction is March 10 at 1p.m.
A fundraising letter is going out. It was passed around for comments. We have received \$750 for the building fund and approximately \$250 for memorials for Ester Ricketts.

EMT-A training

Since we do not have liability insurance, students would not be able to work in the hospital. The insurance would cost \$1,500-2,000. James is pursuing using the Kellogg Ambulance insurance. Training needs to be completed by May 11 so the situation needs to be set within a month.
