James reported on his plan for receiving money for the large (about \$3,300) **matching grant**. His first target is beer distributors, then large employers of the Silver Valley.

**IDL** has four **fire vehicles** for sale for \$1000 each. It was decided to try to get one that would fit in the Murray station. The motion passed to go ahead and get one if we could do that and stay within \$8,000 expenses for the year.

Efforts go ahead to **sell** the Seagraves and the old Murray vehicle.

James discussed **Wal-Mart funds** available, especially "heros" grants that we could get for a halogen bar.

James presented a **structured fundraising/budgeting plan**. No action was taken.

Each summer we provide Shoshone Work Camp with an **automatic external defibulator**. We will get another one covered by \$1003 from the county and private donation.
